



## CLUBHOUSE RE-OPENING GUIDANCE NOTE TO MEMBERS

Following the relaxation of COVID-19 “lockdown” the club is able to re-open its bar from Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> July 2020 and to play cricket from Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> July 2020.

Our intended first formal opening of the bar will be Friday 10<sup>th</sup> July for junior training. From there on we will open to members when there are fixtures and on club training nights.

The committee have undertaken a detailed risk assessment of the facility in conjunction with the government guidelines for hospitality venues and Sport England and ECB advice. Further club guidance will be issued to coaches, players, parents and officials in respect of game play protocol once ECB guidance is updated in respect of the return to playing cricket.

We are hopeful that there will be adapted league programmes for adult men, ladies and juniors between 18<sup>th</sup> July and mid-late September.

In terms of the bar members and guests should be aware of the following: -

- A system of self-screening of individuals will be in place. Before you depart home for the club you should ensure that you are not displaying ANY COVID-19 symptoms. If you are, you should not travel or attend the club.
- The club will require all visitors (including members) to sign in. Non-members will be required to provide contact information. These details are solely to allow “track and trace” to be undertaken in the event we are advised someone has been diagnosed with COVID-19. Contact information for non-members will be deleted after 21 days.
- In order to minimise risks to your fellow members and guests please respect all signage and social distancing requirements.
- Our intention is that upstairs bar and balcony will be accessible only to committee and bar volunteers. Tables and chairs will be located in the open air in front of the clubhouse. A small number of gazebos will be available in case of rain.
- A table service or text messaging system will be in place to take bar orders. The bar will be able to provide a range of alcoholic and soft drinks, hot drinks, crisps, peanuts and bars of chocolate. Drinks and snacks will be delivered to your table in single use disposable glasses. Hot drinks will be served in disposable cups. Please use the bins provided to dispose of your empties.
- We request that payments for bar orders are made by card only.
- The changing rooms, kit cupboards, groundsman’s shed and scoreboard will be remain closed and out of bounds at all times other than to the committee.
- Toilets will be opened in the disabled toilet and the umpires room. Soap and paper towels will be provided for hand washing. Please place paper towels in the bins provided. Toilets and other regular touch points (door handles, gate latch) will be cleaned regularly.



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- The clubhouse and toilets will be thoroughly cleaned prior to opening.
- The tables and chairs in front of the clubhouse are meant for those people using the bar. Chairs will be kept separately for players waiting to bat in a game. We would request that spectators (parents or opposition spectators) bring their own collapsible chairs.
- Hand sanitiser will be placed at selected points around the clubhouse area should members wish to utilise it. All guests are encouraged to sanitise and/or wash their hands regularly. Guidance on hand washing technique will be placed by hand basins.
- In the event of someone being taken ill with COVID-19 symptoms whilst at the club, they will be asked to self-isolate in the umpires room and make arrangements to be collected as soon as possible by a member of their household. They should then seek medical advice from 111. During the self-isolation no other person will be permitted in the umpires room; and the room will be cleaned thoroughly after they have left.
