JUNIOR CLUB RULES

The club believes that it is important that members, coaches, administrators and parents, carers or guardians associated with the club should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others. Therefore, members are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with Craig McWhinnie, Club Welfare Officer or Stafford Williams, Colts Co-ordinator.

As a member of Ivybridge Cricket Club you are expected to abide by the following junior club rules:

- All members must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions.
- All members must respect opponents.
- Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late.
- Members must wear suitable kit (white t-shirt or cricket shirt, white cricket trousers and training shoes or cricket spikes for matches, tracksuit bottoms or shorts can be substituted for cricket trousers for training) for training and match sessions, as agreed with the coach/team manager. Coloured kit is used for older age groups matches and can be acquired from the club, spares are kept for anyone who is unable to acquire the coloured kit for any reason.
- Members must pay any fees for training or events promptly.
- Junior members are not allowed to smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.
- Junior members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.
- Junior members should abide by any government or ECB guidelines laid down in respect of COVID-19 or any similar future pandemic.
